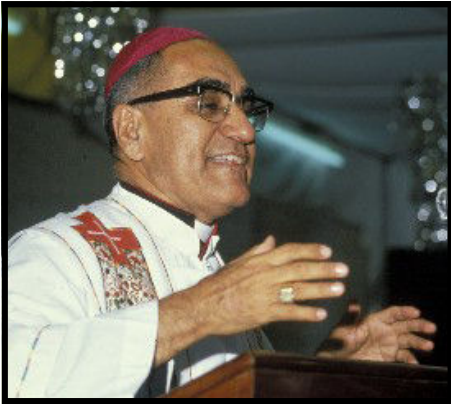


El Salvador

Meet with people of faith, dedication, and courage who seek to improve their country from within. Walk the holy ground of sites where Archbishop Romero, the 4 North American churchwomen and others were murdered.

- Learn of significant moments in Salvadoran history from Equipo Maiz staff.
- Visit a hospital that serves only the poor.
- Walk in the footsteps of the revered Archbishop Romero: visit the site of his martyrdom, his simple bungalow and the new Cathedral where his tomb has become a pilgrimage site for prayer and hope.
- Be inspired by a presentation at a rural cooperative in San Vicente that teaches organic farming methods where fruit and organic cashews are grown, and organic milk nourishes children.
- Visit a small village near San Salvador and learn of their challenges.
- Hear experiences of the *Mothers of the Disappeared*, an organization dedicated to truth in history and reparations for victims.
- Meet with youth leaders who are active agents for change in their country.
- Interact with students at a bi-lingual school.
- Learn of the importance of water projects.
